

## Nicholas Bervinchak

Born in 1903 in the northeastern Pennsylvania coal region to parents from the Lemko village of Rzepedz, Nicholas Bervinchak was a coal miner-turned-artist whose work became displayed worldwide, including in the Whitney Museum of Art, National Gallery of Art, Smithsonian Institution and White House.
